

YOKOHAMA AUTOCROSS & OPERATION UPDATE

As most of you are sadly aware by now, our **Yokohama Tire** Autocross season start has been postponed.

Autocross School, Autocross 1, and the Tire Rack Challenge have been cancelled.

With a significant amount of hope following the announcement from the federal government on April 16th on how shelter-in-place can begin to be eased, we are still planning to hold our remaining events this season as long as various levels of government, our venue hosts, and national BMW CCA allow us. Stating that, participant safety is first and foremost, so here are a few changes we will be implementing this year to ensure everyone stays healthy and safe:

Social distancing will be required all season

- this is the most obvious practice we will maintain, as our event attendees range from little children to pensioners. Luckily, autocross is done in open parking lots where spreading out is easy!

Increased cleanliness and sanitization – We will have extra hand sanitizer as well as a portable hand wash station available at our events. We will provide sanitizing wipes or spray for shared equipment (radios, flags, timing equipment, etc.) Sanitizing wipes will not be available for your personal equipment. If possible, please bring your own sanitizer for your personal use to limit how quickly we use club supplies.

No loaner helmets – In line with increasing cleanliness and sanitization, our helmets are probably the dirtiest thing at our events (aside from Larry, of course!) and will not be available at all this season. As a reminder, helmets must be rated Snell 2010 or newer.

No autocross cookies or water– Multiple people grabbing cookies or water from a shared container does not promote a clean environment, so we will unfortunately not have event cookies/water this year.

Registration packet, waiver signing, and wristbands will be handled in a no contact manner – we are still fine-tuning this, but you will likely have to grab your own envelope from a separate table, sign the waiver, and put on your wristband on your own. You will be supervised doing this to comply with our insurance requirements, but it will be done at an appropriate distance.

No in-car instruction – Because we cannot maintain social distancing, in car instruction will not be available this season. We will do our best to implement external instruction as we are able.

Expansion of our refund policy – Currently, participants are able to request a refund or roll registration fees to a future event 24 hours before an autocross. We are expanding this to 9:00 am (or 30 minutes before driver's

meeting) the day of the event if we are notified via email (autocross@windycitybmw.com) that you cannot attend due to illness or potential prior exposure.

Your help and compliance with these new operation standards are what will allow us to run events this year. A participant becoming ill due to not following these new procedures is a great way to end our autocross program completely. As such, failure to comply with new operating procedures will be handled accordingly.

Now, to some good news!

First, our new timing equipment is in! This improved wireless system not only should further expand on our course design creativity but also improve functionality and reliability. Second, we will still be able to have six regular season events this year!

Under our prior event schedule, we had a seventh season event opportunity lined up with Tri-State Sport Car Council to be held at Route 66 on Saturday, September 5th. Fortunately for us, that weekend is a "double-header" weekend for TSSCC, who are running an event on September 6th as well. They have graciously extended the Sunday event to us and we plan on participating. This will be our first double points event weekend in recent history. but it will still provide everyone the opportunity to still have a full autocross season. They will be extending their member rates to us at \$40 per event, however, they operate under SCCA insurance. As such, you will need to pay a \$15 weekend membership fee if you are not an SCCA member. This is valid for the whole weekend, so it will apply for either or both TSSCC days. If you do decide to become an SCCA member afterwards, this \$15 fee can be applied towards your full membership. Here is the revised schedule:

Yokohama Event VI @ Sears – Sunday, September 27th As with all things, this unique time we find ourselves in too shall pass. Indischleife Fall Tour 2020

Are you tired of being stuck inside and unable to see your Windy City BMW friends? Well it is time to come out of hiding and stretch those legs. Hop in the car and join us for the 3-day tour we have been looking forward too, for months and months. The application for the 2020 Indischleife Fall Tour is finally here! We will be starting our journey October 2nd, early Friday morning at the Tippecanoe Battlefield in West Lafayette, Indiana. One of our sponsors, Clean Tools, the creator of the ABSORBER, has been generous enough to gift our guests, some goodies for our cars. Cleantools.net Starting time will be around 9am Eastern time. It is an hour ahead, so a Thursday night hotel is an option for us nearby at the Comfort Suites Lafayette University Area in Lafayette, Indiana. Phone # 1-765-447-0016. From there, we will zig zag around the state and do some sightseeing. We will run into some Boilermakers, a railroad museum, a toy store, a few covered bridges and some of Windy City's favorites, twisty roads! Our final destination for Friday will be our hotel for the weekend. The Seasons Lodge in Nashville, Indiana. Phone # 1-800-365-7327. Seasonslodge.com. Friday's drive, you will be on your own for lunch and dinner. Bring some cash for the trip just in case you want to see a museum or 2. There may be some minor entry fees for the museums if you are interested. Nashville has plenty of choices for entertainment and food. Bloomington, Indiana is another option for dinner Friday night, and it is only 20 minutes away.

Saturday morning, October 3rd, we will be starting off with a continental breakfast, generously paid for by our second sponsor, Siemens Industries new.siemens. com We will be starting our drive around 9am after a quick meeting. Our Start/Finish line will be the Seasons Lodge. The drive will be a loop that replicates the Nurburgring racetrack from Nurburg, Germany. The roads will take us around Brown County State Park in southern Indiana. The day will be dedicated more to the drive and the great roads, rather than stopping at destinations along the way. There will be plenty of places to stop just in case you need to stretch your legs, including cave tours, covered bridges, a weird tall rock, look out points, a winery, and a few Hoosiers. After we conquer the Indiana Ring, we will finish up the evening for a cocktail hour around 6pm and have dinner around 7pm at the Seasons Lodge banquet center next door. Your dinner Saturday night will be part of the fee in the application. Dinner will be a buffet including country fried chicken, pot roast and grilled salmon for the main dishes. Potato salad, pasta salad, green beans, and mashed potato for the sides. The buffet will include desserts, coffee, iced tea, and water.



A cash bar will be available for 3 hours. If you have any special needs for food allergies, please let me know so I can let the hotel know prior to the dinner. We will have some goodies to give away at the end of the night thanks to our third generous sponsor, Laurel BMW of Westmont. Laurelbmw.com.

Sunday is fun day! October 4th. This will be a day dedicated to whatever you want to do. There will be a GT World Challenge 8-hour endurance race at the Indianapolis Motor speedway, approximately an hour away from the hotel. Tickets are available, so grab them soon if you are interested. I will also have a list of places to visit in the general area including places to go horseback riding, zip lining, hiking, history, overlook towers, a pioneer village, and the Wonderlab Science Museum. If you would like to wander further out, I have some other interesting places to visit as well. French Lick, Indiana, Hemlock Cliffs, Louisville Slugger Museum and Factory, and George Rogers Clark National Historical Park.

The cost for the tour will be \$60 per driver, \$45 per guest and \$20 per child 10 and under. We will be supplying some snacks and water for the drive for Friday and Saturday. It may be helpful to bring a small cooler if you want to keep your water cold or pick up some fudge on the way! This year we will have an option for a black long sleeve mock turtleneck shirt, with the Indischleife Ring logo on it. If you are interested, mark it on the application. The deadline for the shirt will be September 11th 2020. The deadline for the tour application needs to be in hand by September 22nd, 2020. Full refunds will be made for the (tour only) if COVID 19 wants to wreak havoc on us still, by September 26th, 2020. If you ordered a shirt, we will not be able to refund your money but you will get your shirt. If you have not booked the hotel room and are still interested in joining us, get a room soon. The Seasons lodge is not a large hotel and they have a limited amount of rooms available. We blocked 30 rooms and 25 are taken. We will have until September 2nd to reserve a blocked room under Windy City BMW. Rooms were \$169 for a standard room and \$189 for a deluxe room.

I appreciate all our sponsors for their generosity. The 3 sponsors we have so far have been a great help to bring the cost of the tour down for our members. The red Porsche wheels had been powder coated previously by the same team and held up OK until they repowder coated them. They got lucky the first time and we do not know how much stiffness was lost the first time. The first batch did not develop any cracks either, another lucky situation. Certainly the second time was a big mistake and they turned into **jello...**

Also, this photo is of a rear wheel, this happened under acceleration. I had NEVER seen anything like this in all my years in the business. In our experience, the high temperature from powder coating typically makes the wheel brittle, these red Porsche wheels became very soft.

Car Control from 2002

The wind blew sideways (as the wind is wont to do) dragging a cold rain with it. We silly humans, blocked the wind's traverse, allowing the moisture to puddle, no, POND at, and on, our feet. Sensible people stayed inside for the day, but we had a mission... (The thunder was ominous sounding, much like the sound of a thin sheet of metal being shaken backstage during the storm scene in a play.) Our 2002 Springtime Safety School is now part of Windy City history. Students started signing up in mid-February and we ended with a full class of 40, with 6 more on the wait list. Of the 46 possibles, 36 showed up to get their tires singing in the rain. After registration and emptying trunk junk out of the cars, we began the day with 90 minutes of classroom instruction. By 11:30AM students were driving the exercises, putting the classroom theory into practice. (The plan was simple, like my brother-in-law Phil. But unlike Phil, this plan just might work.)

Students drove on a skid pad to learn how their cars feel just before they begin to lose control ...and how to regain control of their cars after they do break loose. They practiced heavy braking using ABS or the threshold braking technique, in both straight-ahead and curved modes. Using a figure 8 exercise, we taught how to effectively use your eyes to guide transition from a curve into a straightaway and back into a sharp curve. The emergency lane change simulation and the slalom were designed to teach students the feel of both abrupt and smooth side to side weight transitions and how to do them without losing control of their

car. (Their thoughts tumbled in their heads, making and breaking alliances like underpants in a dryer without Cling Free.) We ended our activity with, seemingly, endless runs through a low-speed autocross made by linking together the elements practiced earlier in the day.

Almost a third of the students qualified as "kids" on Randy's scale (As I get older the range expands, but I presently include drivers from 16 to 21.) One young lady had had her license for a full 7 days before we got to her. The perfect candidate. Not a lot of old baggage to train out of her, just a clean slate to write on. Some of our, em... more mature students brought a significant number of bad driving habits gleaned from years of "experience". We spent almost as much time erasing as writing, but their slates were commendable at day's end, also.

Many thanks to all those who helped out during the day, especially those who planned to just watch or maybe sign in a student and take off. Your willingness to stick it out through weather fit for neither man nor beast was put to good purpose. (The little boat gently drifted across the flooded parking lot, exactly the way a bowling ball wouldn't.) WAY BACK MACHINE: 1969 MUNICH


You're probably thinking this story is because I'm sitting at home "minding my knitting." You know the "stay at home" thing.
